Research in Progress

"Cross-Institutional Investigation of Faculty Publishing" (Writing Results).

Researchers from Texas State University, University of Miami, and the University of Northern Colorado are conducting research across the United States and Canada on faculty attitudes regarding journal quality and selection criteria, including aspects of academic unit's culture and publication history.

"Faculty Attitudes and Knowledge of Journal Quality and Publishing Practices" (On-Going).

Examines UNC faculty knowledge of predatory journals and the impact journal quality may have on their own work and their perception of peers' work.

"Research Guides as an Avenue for Informal Learning" (Writing Results).

"Systematic Review of Faculty Criteria for Journal Selection" (On-Going).

Studies of various disciplines and geographic focus have investigated the criteria that faculty researchers look for and prioritize when selecting journals in which to publish their manuscripts. As no studies have sought to synthesize these results, this line of research seeks to complete a rapid review to create a benchmark for this area of research.
