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Meningitis Acknowledgement -

Medical Acknowledgement - The State of Colorado requires the meningitis vaccine for any student living in student housing. You must acknowledge that you have received the vaccine within the last five (5) years. If you have elected not to have the vaccine, you must still read and acknowledge that you understand the risks of this deadly disease and are declining the vaccine. Meningococcal disease is a highly contagious, but a largely preventable infection of the spinal cord fluid and the fluid that surrounds the brain. Scientific evidence suggests that college students living in shared housing facilities are at a modestly increased risk of contracting Meningococcal disease. Immunization against Meningococcal disease decreases the risk of contracting the disease.

Vaccination Records: In addition to the required vaccine against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) required for all students, on campus residents must have a Meningitis (type ACWY) vaccine given within the last three years (Note: you may decline the meningitis vaccine but may be subject to exclusion from campus in the event of an outbreak). The Gender Inclusive Housing Program allows students of different genders to live together in the same room. Gender Inclusive Housing is not a Residential Learning Community and does not exist solely on one floor or in one community. Housing & Residential Education wants all students, regardless of gender identity, to have the option to choose a space in a hall that best meets their needs.
