BS Audiology & Speech-Language Pathology (cont.)

This worksheet is a <u>recommended schedule</u> to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 31 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Curriculum; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students** must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.

Notes

- In this comprehensive pre-professional program, students take academic courses and observe and participate in supervised clinical practica. These activities are designed to provide a strong base for entry into a professional certifying degree program at the master's degree level in speech-language pathology or at the doctoral degree level in audiology. This degree program does not lead to certification of any type. Students cannot find employment as a licensed or certified audiologist or a speech-language pathologist with only the bachelor's degree in audiology and speech-language sciences; however, positions can be found as audiology technicians and/or speech-language pathology assistants.

In addition to fulfilling the specified major requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree in Audiology and Speech-Language Sciences, a grade of "C-" or better must be earned in all of the Required Major Credit courses in order for the courses to count toward the major. In addition, the University requirement of a UNC cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 for graduation must also be met.
