

Graduate Internship in Cancer Rehabilitation

University of Northern Colorado Cancer Rehabilitation Institute (UNCCRI)

UNCCRI was established in 1996 and is a state-of-the art rehabilitation facility located in the Ben Nighthorse Campbell Center for Natural and Health Sciences. Our clinical program involves collection and analysis of pre and post exercise intervention data from cancer survivors. The 3-month exercise intervention includes cardiorespiratory, muscular, flexibility, and balance training designed to alleviate the debilitating effects of cancer and cancer-related fatigue.

The University of Northern Colorado Cancer Rehabilitation Institute is committed to improving the quality of life of cancer survivors during and following cancer treatment through prescriptive exercise rehabilitation.

Internship Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science or health related field
- Knowledge of exercise assessment (treadmill testing, body composition, spirometry, muscular strength/ endurance, flexibility/ROM), exercise prescription, and exercise programming (Experience desired)
- Current First Aid, CPR, and AED Certification
- Must be available a minimum of 30 hours per week for 17 weeks
- Weekend work may be occasionally required

Internship Opportunities/Requirements

- Completion of our 3-credit course SES 505
 (Exercise Programming for Cancer Patients) or demonstrate competence in all clinical skills at UNCCRI
- Clinical Cancer Exercise Specialist Certification available for a cost of \$100
- Medically screen cancer patients
- Conduct exercise assessments and reassessments of cancer patients
- Write exercise prescriptions for cancer patients
- Develop and implement exercise interventions for cancer patients
- Assist the UNCCRI Director, Clinical Coordinator, and other staff with various aspects of UNCCRI policies, procedures, data collection and management.
