Karen Chin is a professor in the Department of Geological Sciences and Curator of Paleontology at the Museum of Natural History at the University of Colorado. Her research focuses on reconstructing ancient ecosystems, primarily through analyses of fossilized feces. These fossils can tell us much about ancient trophic (feeding) interactions, the movement and recycling of nutrients in paleoecosystems, and complex processes of fossilization.
