### Program Requirements:

- 2.5+ GPA, overall and in mathematics
- Praxis test needs to be attempted before registering for STEP 363 and passed by mid-Fall for student teaching in Spring 2021.
  - Secondary Education program students take 5161 (min. score to pass is 153)
  - Middle School Ed. program students take 5169 (min. Score to pass is 165)
  - Costs \$120 per attempt
- STEP 161 and 363 must be taken in the Fall and STEP 262 must be taken in the Spring with MED 341. Also, STEP 363 needs to be taken with MED 441.
