BIO 245 — Introduction to Human Anatomy & Physiology (4)	BMS 301 <i>This course transfers into UNC as BIO 341. Upon admission into the nursing program, we will substitute this course for the BIO 245 requirement.</i>	BIO 201
BIO 246 — Advanced Human Anatomy & Physiology (3)	BMS 300 + BMS 302 <i>The combination of these two courses transfer into UNC as BIO 350. Upon admission into the nursing program, we will substitute these courses for the BIO 246 requirement.</i>	BIO 202
BIO 251 — Allied Health Microbiology (4)	LIFE 205 + LIFE 206 = BIO 251 MIP 300 + MIP 302 = BIO 351 [^] <i>^Upon admission into the nursing program, we will substitute these courses for the BIO 251 requirement.</i>	BIO 204
NURS 326 — Pathophysiology (3)	BMS 460 <i>This course transfers into UNC as BIO 4XX. Upon admission into the nursing program, we will substitute this course for the NURS 326 requirement.</i>	BIO 216 (4 credits) <i>3-credit course is NOT equivalent</i>

*STAT 150 — Introduction to Statistical Analysis (3)	STAT 201	MAT 135
