Retirement

Colorado schools offer PERA Retirement Benefits.

- Your eligibility for retirement is based on #years teaching + age
- For example, if you begin teaching when you are 22 years old, under the 90+ rule you are eligible to retire when you are 56. The PERA calculator shows that a person who does this will earn ~90% of their highest salary as their pension.
