  - Marshall Parks, Director of Human Resources- HR update
    - Handed out packet of information with new Insurance changes
      - See attached packet in the minutes
    - Shared an overview of each aspect of changes
      - o If current doctors aren't in network, share that with HR to see if we can get them in.
      - Everyone will be issued a new insurance card
    - Civil Unions and Domestic Partnership rules have changed to the benefit of employees
    - HMO (BlueAdvantage) is basically unchanged
    - PPO (PRIME Blue Priority) will now require a PCP, but is mostly unchanged
    - Blue Priority HMO is a new, narrow-network plan (similar to Kaiser Permanente) with slightly lower premiums, but higher out of pocket costs
    - Lumenos PPO is a high-deductible plan (\$2,500 individual) with a low premium
    - HR Staff is available to speak to offices and departments to explain or share
    - Patient Advocate Link can help staff compare plans (including spouses' options)
    - December premium holiday will likely come this year, but may not in future years with changes
