- 4. PASC Ad Hoc Committee, Faculty Senate, Salary Equity Updates Heise
 - a. Check in about budget impact ad hoc committee
 - i. Survey of staff impact was placed on hold last fall pending changes
 - ii. Transitions are still very much underway should we continue to wait, or check in with staff about the changes?
 - 1. PASC expressed waiting until more changes were finalized too much is still in flux
 - b. Faculty Senate and Salary Equity
 - i. They are requesting additional data on cuts that have been made that should be available soon

 - 1. The 77 eliminated vacancies are permanently gone, however, there are still active vacancies that may be filled
 - 2. Vacancy rate is unnaturally higher than normal this year because of 60 day holds on hiring, but are numbers that PASC would like to see, especially over time.
 - iv. Layoffs note from Mueller that students do not necessarily understand variations in faculty
