Goals

Cultural Competence Defined...



"a set of congruent behaviors, attitudes, and policies that come together in a system, agency, or amongst professionals and enables that system, agency or those professionals to work effectively in cross-cultural situations"



Process of Cultural Competence



Cultural Awareness

Self-examination of one's own cultural background and adherence to heritage





Cultural Desire

The stimulus driving one to engage in and be receptive to the process of interacting with diverse groups.



<u>Cultural Knowledge</u>

Seeking and obtaining sound educational knowledge.



Cultural Skill

The ability to collect and assimilate relevant cultural data. Culturally appropriate conduct.

Cultural Encounters

Direct engagement in cross-cultural interactions.

Considerations for All



- Demonstrate desire
 - Start with yourself!
- Create safe spaces
 - Avoid minimizing behaviors
 - Listen without being defensive
- Invest in their social capital
 - Validate our experiences
 - Connect us with resources

Considerations for Interpreter Educators



- Acknowledge lack of critical mass
 - Recruitment strategies
 - Bear the burden
- Invest in their social capital
 - Paid distance mentoring
 - Connection to resources
- Design a Multicultural Curriculum
 - NMIP, NIEC Social Justice Infusion
 - Demand Control Schema & Encounters with Reality


