SB-24-164 Transfer Transparency

- 30-day requirement for transfer notification
- Right to appeal decisions
- GTP Focused
- Updating transfer library to be term-driven (See example on back)
 - Term-driven reflects course history at UNC, including GTP and LAC attributes.

Transfer Evaluation Timelines

- 5-7 business days to process and evaluate transcripts
- 48-72 hours response time for emails to transfereval@unco.edu. If you need immediate assistance, please reach out to us via Teams.
- 30-day response time for faculty approvals and appeals
- Study abroad course approvals happen before departure- students need evals to register

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the requirements for Transfer?

- Only 90 semester credits transferred apply to the degree and courses must have a "C-" or higher
- AA, AS, BA, BS from institutionally accredited schools waive (LAC) requirements
- AAS, AGS, and BAS degrees are not transferable and do not waive the LAC requirements
