This worksheet is a recommended schedule to complete your bachelor’s degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor’s degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student’s major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

- 1 COMM 100 and 101 must be taken concurrently.
- 2 A minimum of 18 semester hours must be 300-400 level COMM courses, with a minimum of six semester hours at the 400-level or above. A maximum of three semester hours of 422 Directed Studies are allowed.  
  
Majors may count one course in a related discipline toward their communication electives. This course must be approved in advance by their major advisor.
- 3 Juniors and seniors with a GPA of 3.0 and higher may register for 500 level COMM courses.
- 4 All required COMM courses (100/101, 102, 201, 220, 330, 343) must be completed prior to taking Capstone.
- 5 Students must have completed 18 semester hours in COMM with a GPA of 2.0 or better to be eligible for an internship. A minimum of 50 hours of internship work must be logged for each one credit earned. A maximum of ten internship credits in COMM is allowed; only six credits may be applied toward fulfilling the major. Students not completing an internship are required to complete six additional credits of COMM electives.
