Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in

the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

Notes

1. English major Electives may be fulfilled with any ENG, FILM, or HUM courses other than those listed as Liberal Art Core courses, with the exception of ENG 236 and ENG 262. Students may count one of the latter courses as a major elective, but not both.
2. Only 9 credits of the ENG prefix may be counted for LAC credits – ENG 122, ENG 123, and ENG 225 do not count as ENG prefix courses.
3. EED 341 is offered only in the spring semester. EED 402 is offered only during the fall semester.
4. STEP 363 must be taken concurrently with EED 341 or EED 402.
5. Admission to Phase III:
 - a. Complete at least 30 hours in the major with a grade point average of 2.75 with no grade lower than a C.
 - b. Retake major courses when a grade of "D" or "F" is received for a grade of "C" or better (C- is not acceptable).
6. EDFE 110 Initial PTEP Application-Prerequisite: Sophomore Status. Submit to STE office in one package: Fingerprint card, current TB test results, Oath and Consent Form, and major content advisor approval form.
7. EDFE 120 Full Admission to PTEP Application-Prerequisite: EDFE 110. Submit to STE office in one package: current TB results, proof of oral/written proficiency, proof of registration for PLACE or PRAXIS, and major content advisor approval form.
8. EDFE 130 Student Teaching Application-Prerequisite: EDFE 210 or EDFE 125. Submit to STE office in one package: current TB results PLACE or PRAXIS exam results and complete on-line Request for Placement. Subject to approval by major content advisor.
