This worksheet is a recommended schedule to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

Notes

1. History majors must obtain a grade of "C" or better (C- is not acceptable) in all history courses taken at UNC. Majors receiving a grade of "C-" or lower in a history course must retake the course—or an equivalent approved by the academic advisor—and receive a grade of "C" or better to have the course counted toward the major.
2. All history courses numbered 300 or higher include a research and writing component.
3. Only 6 hours of HIST prefixes may be counted toward the LAC.
4. History majors must complete a minor of at least 18 semester hours, preferably within the College of Humanities and Social Sciences.
5. The study of foreign language is recommended for those majors who plan to pursue graduate study in history.
