This worksheet is a recommended schedule to complete your bachelor’s degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor’s degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student’s major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements**

Notes

- 1 All work to be counted toward the degree must be beyond the first year level.
- 2 Unless otherwise noted, all courses with a GER prefix are conducted in German.
- 3 Students must demonstrate competency in certain areas of language activity: oral and written proficiency in foreign language, ability to apply one's knowledge of the culture to appropriate situations in a foreign language environment.
- 4 To graduate with a Foreign Language degree, students must have a 2.5 GPA in those courses that count toward the major and were taken at UNC.
- 5 Opportunity for study abroad (junior year recommended).
- 6 Students must pass the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) with a rating in the Intermediate range in order to graduate. See your advisor for more information.

The German Liberal Arts Major stresses communicative language learning that recognizes language acquisition as a dynamic process of discovery in which students develop the ability to use the German language for specific communication purposes. This skill-using approach is obtained through content-based instruction at all levels and is complemented by authentic audio visual and textual materials. Optional participation in extracurricular programs and activities that include immersion weekends and conversation circle (*Stammtisch*) further enhance functional proficiency.
