This worksheet is a recommended schedule to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

**Notes**

- History majors must obtain a grade of "C" or better (C- is not acceptable) in all history courses taken at UNC. Majors receiving a grade of "C-" or lower in a history course must retake the course—or an equivalent approved by the academic advisor—and receive a grade of "C" or better to have the course counted toward the major.
- All history courses numbered 300 or higher include a research and writing component.
- Only 6 hours of HIST prefixes may be counted toward the LAC.
- History majors must complete a minor of at least 18 semester hours, preferably within the College of Humanities and Social Sciences.
- The study of foreign language is recommended for those majors who plan to pursue graduate study in history.
