The Retroactive Credit policy allows for credit for 100 and 200 level courses. The Heritage Speaker's Option allows substitution of SPAN 310 + SPAN 311 + Span 312 for the SPAN 301 + SPAN 302 +SPAN 303 sequence. Contact the Hispanic Studies Dept. for the placement test and additional info. This sample schedule includes 33 hours of SPAN 300-400 level courses, 40 hours of Liberal Arts Core, 9 hours of University-wide electives, and 38 PTEP hours. Total: 120 hours.
