Admission Requirement – Art & Design students must complete the First-Year Foundation requirements before they can begin their advanced art studies. The First-Year Foundation Courses include Art 181, 182, 183, 184, and 234, which must be completed with a 2.8 GPA. Students also must successfully complete the Foundations Portfolio.

To graduate with a B.A. in Art & Design, all students must earn a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher in all courses in the major.

PTEP Review: Before receiving approval to student teach, student must complete the comprehensive Art Education PTEP review. See Student catalog for Details on Program Requirements.

Concentration: a minimum of 6 credit hours of 300 level or above coursework in one of the Art Concentration areas. Concentration options are Ceramics, Digital Media, Drawing, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, or Sculpture.

Minor Required – No minors required.
