This four-year graduation plan assumes that a student is entering as a Freshman and takes 15 semester hours each term. It further assumes that the Liberal Arts Core courses will be spread out over four years and Student Electives are all taken toward the end of the program; the program can therefore be completed in four years with a total of 120 semester hours (48 for the major, 40 for the Liberal Art Core courses, and 32 electives). There are no prescribed general education courses; this major does not require a minor.
