Admission Requirement – Admission is based on a minimum GPA of 2.5. Applications are reviewed for fall and spring semester by the School of Nursing faculty.

Minor – No minor required.

Notes:

1. Students will be admitted on a staggered basis. One group will start in the spring session, the other group in the fall.
2. Liberal Arts Core requires a minimum of 40 credits hours; at least 31 credit hours of these shall be taken in areas 1 through 6.
3. Students should apply for graduation via e-mail upon completion of their fourth semester.
4. Students with a previous RN are awarded 40 hours of upper division nursing course work per the Colorado Articulation Agreement upon completion of three semesters of full time nursing course work at UNC. Total credits required for RN's (120).
5. A minimum grade of C or better (C- is not acceptable) or satisfactory in all nursing courses required for progression to the next semester must be earned.

Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**
