Notes

*This suggested schedule assumes that a student will begin with entry level Spanish. There are several options for receiving Spanish credit by taking Advanced Placement and IB courses in High School, the CLEP test, and/or our program's placement test to determine the appropriate level to begin. The Retroactive Credit policy allows for credit for 100 and 200 level courses. The Heritage Speaker's Option allows substitution of SPAN 310 + Span 312 for the SPAN 301 + SPAN 302 sequence. Contact the Hispanic Studies Dept. for the placement test and additional info. This sample schedule will satisfy a Spanish major's 36 hour requirement for 300-400 level courses in the major, an 18 hour minor, 37 hours of Liberal Arts Core, and will provide for 29 hours of University-wide electives. Total : 120 hours.
