sample, letters of recommendation, a minimum of 9 credits in the ENG major, and a GPA of 3.0 overall and in the major. These requirements were put into place to address concerns voiced in response to the 2007 NCATE Report regarding AREA 3. "Description of the criteria for admission, retention, and exit from the program, including required GPAs and minimum grade requirements for the content courses accepted by the program."
