This four-year plan assumes that a student is entering as a Freshman and takes roughly 15 semester hours each term. It further assumes that the Liberal Arts Curriculum courses will be spread out over four years and Student Electives are all taken toward the end of the program; the program can therefore be completed in four years with a total of 120 semester hours (48 for the major, 31 for the Liberal Art Curriculum courses, and 41 electives). There are no prescribed general education courses; this major does not require a minor. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

Notes – Not every course is offered every year; specific courses of interest should be taken at your earliest convenience. Summer Offerings (most, but not all summers): ANT 110, 120, 130, 335, 325/525

Additional Anthropology courses may be taken as University-wide electives. Consult with your advisor regarding options and opportunities for enhancing your Anthropology experience.
