Each major and/or concentration may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

Notes:

1. A minimum of 18 semester hours must be 300-400 level COMM courses, with a minimum of six semester hours at the 400-level or above. A maximum of three semester hours of 422 Directed Studies are allowed.
2. Juniors and Seniors with a GPA of 3.0 and higher may register for 500 level COMM courses.

3. All required COMM courses (100, 102, 201, 220, 330, 343) must be completed prior to taking 491 Capstone. Permission of instructor is needed to register for COMM 491.
4. Students must have completed 18 semester hours in COMM with a GPA of 3.0 or better to be eligible for an internship. A minimum of 50 hours of internship work must be logged for each one credit earned. A maximum of ten internship credits in COMM is allowed; only six credits may be applied toward fulfilling the major. Students not completing an internship are required to complete six additional credits of COMM electives.
