- Instructor initiates the form that is found in the “Forms” section under “Registration” on the Office of the Registrar’s webpage: (<https://www.unco.edu/registrar/forms.aspx>).
 - After clicking on the desired form, Instructor will log-in by using their UNC authentication credentials:

- Before submitting the form, quickly review it to make sure all information is correct and all fields are populated, and then click the

Submit button at the bottom of the page:



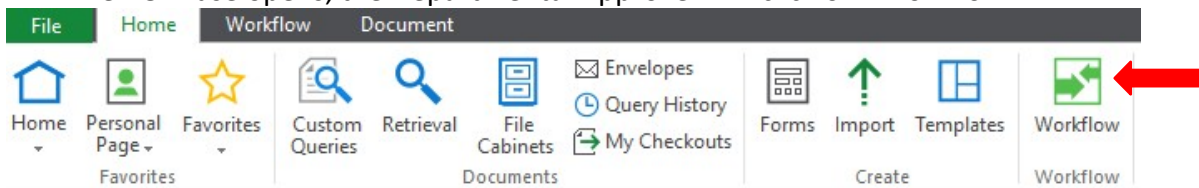
- The Instructor and Student will then receive an email with the completed form attached. That email prompts the student and instructor to check over the information to make sure it was submitted as desired. The Department/Chair approver also receives an email that states they have a form in OnBase awaiting their approval.
- Departmental Approver logs into OnBase Production using the Unity Client:



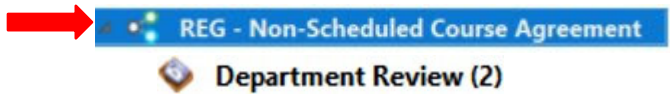
- After clicking on the Unity Client, this bigger screen takes a moment to open.



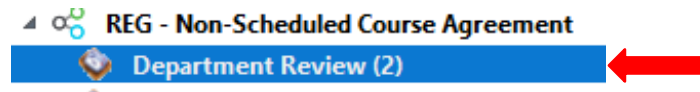
- When OnBase opens, the Departmental Approver will click on “Workflow”



- Find the Non-Scheduled Course Agreements folder from the selections on the left and then open it by using the arrow. The Department Review file is located under that section when the arrow is pointing downward. The number next to the
- “Department Review” indicates how many forms are in the file for review. In this example, there are two forms in this queue for review.



- Click on the Department Review line. The student’s name(s) will appear in the upper box on the right side of the screen.

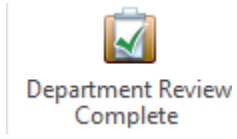
- Click on the student’s entry that you want to review. That student’s Non-Scheduled Course form will populate in the lower (larger) window.
- Review the information making sure all fields are correct and the course matches the catalogue specifications for Title and Credits.
- Department Approver then selects “Approve” or “Deny” from the drop down in the
- “Department Approval Status” field.



- Department Approver then clicks the “Save” button at the bottom of the form.



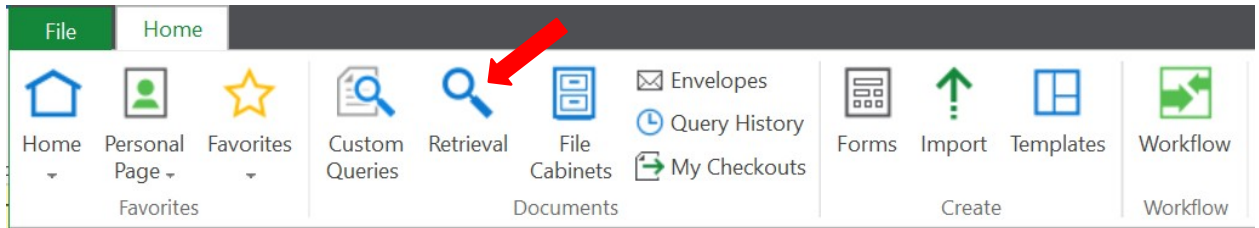
- Department Approver then returns to the top bar in OnBase and clicks on the
 - “Department Review Complete” button.



- The student that was just approved or denied will no longer show in the Department Approver’s queue. The Department Approver can now review another student’s file by selecting them in the upper box, or they can exit OnBase.
- Instructor and Student now get an email with the status of the form.
 - If the form was denied by the Department, the faculty and student will need to start it anew if they wish to resubmit the form.
 - If the form was approved, it now moves to the Registrar’s queue.
- Once in the Registrar’s queue, if there is missing or incomplete data, an “action needed” email will be sent to the instructor and student. The form will not be sent back. Communication to fix the form must be emailed back to the Registrar’s Office

at registrar@unco.edu Attn: "Directed Studies" or "Non-Sched Studies" before the add deadline of the course.

- Once the form is approved and processed by the Registrar's Office, an email with the attached finalized form will be sent to the student and instructor for their records.
- Department Administrators can access the forms through the Retrieval icon on the Home page of OnBase.
