

Graduate Student Permit to Carry an Overload

An overload is more than 17 credit hours for Fall and Spring terms and 12 credit hours for the Summer term. The Interim term has a 4 credit hour limit: no overload will be permitted. ***Upon approval and Office of the Registrar processing, student is responsible for schedule changes.*** Overload limitations apply to work completed in both on-campus and off-campus programs. Additional tuition charges may apply.

A graduate student with a GPA lower than 3.0 may not petition for an overload.
