Subject: 2018 NSF-MRI Proposal Competition – SPONSOR REVISED RFP;

**DEADLINES EXTENDED** 

Date: November 29, 2017 – REVISED 10/27/17; 11/29/17

The NSF Major Research Instrumentation Program ('NSF-MRI'; RFP #18-513) serves to increase access to shared-use/multi-user instrumentation for scientific and engineering research and research training. The NSF proposal submission window for this program is **January 29, 2018** - **February 05, 2018**. It is estimated that NSF will grant up to 150 MRI awards in FY 2018.

An NSF-MRI proposal may request up to \$4 million for either acquisition or development of a research instrument. Beginning with the FY 2018 competition, each organization may submit in revised "Tracks" as defined below, with no more than two submissions in Track 1 and no more than one submission in Track 2:

- **Track 1** proposals requesting funds from NSF greater than or equal to \$100,000<sup>1</sup> and less than \$1,000,000.
- Track 2 proposals requesting funds from NSF greater than or equal to \$1,000,000 up to and including \$4,000,000.

Because this is a limited submission program, UNC will hold an internal competition if more than **three** notices of intent for the NSF-MRI program are submitted by the deadline below. The OSP <u>policy on limited submissions</u> specifies the procedures for selecting limited submissions proposals.

PIs should notify OSP of their intent to submit an NSF-MRI proposal by completing a Notice of Intent to Submit (NOI) through the OSP website by December 08, 2017. If OSP receives more than three notices by the deadline, the timeline for the internal selection shall proceed as follows:

Dec 08	Notices of Intent are due to OSP
Dec 11	PIs notified if pre-proposal process is required
Dec 18	pre-proposals for internal selection due
Dec 22	applicants notified of selection decision
Jan 29, 2018	all final proposal documents submitted to OSP for review
Feb 05	NSF-MRI proposal deadline (last date to submit to NSF)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Proposals requesting funds from NSF less than \$100,000 will be accepted only for the disciplines of mathematics or social, behavioral and economic sciences.
