Dr. Robert (Bob) Houser has served as the AVPR since September 2014. Dr. Houser served previously at UNC as the Associate Dean of the College of Natural and Health Sciences (NHS), where his primary responsibilities were in faculty affairs and research development in NHS. Additionally, Dr. Houser hold the rank of Professor in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at UNC. Prior to coming to UNC, Dr. Houser gained valuable experience in both faculty and administrative roles at the University of Oklahoma, where he joining the faculty of the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry in 1999 and served as Assistant Chair of the department from 2006 to 2010. Dr. Houser earned a bachelor's degree in Chemistry from Colorado State University in 1987 and a Ph.D. in Chemistry from the University of Minnesota in 1996. He completed a postdoctoral fellowship at the California Institute of Technology with Professor Jacqueline K. Barton from 1996 to 1999. His non-academic leadership and administrative experience included more than four years as an active duty U.S. Army officer from 1987 to 1991.
