



Steps for Checking Your Class Schedule


1 Log in to **URSA** and click 'Register, Add or Drop/Withdraw Classes'




Click 'View Registration Information'




3 Review information about days/times of class meetings by clicking the 'Schedule Details' area




4 If the Instructional Method is "Face to Face," the class will meet during all of the days/times listed on your schedule.






5 If the Instructional Method is "Mixed Face-to-Face" the class will meet during at least some of the times listed but not all of them. Your instructor will provide details by the first day of class.





6 If the Instructional Method is "Distance/Online" and there are days/times listed on the schedule, it means the course will have live meetings (usually on Zoom) during some or all of those times. Your instructor will provide details by the first day of class.


