- Attending leadership workshops, programs, and Institute social events. Mandatory all-day Saturday workshops will be held approximately once per month during the academic year for first-year cohorts. All dates are listed at the end of this application.
- Full participation includes, completing all assignments as assigned between workshops as well as maintaining communication thorough efforts made by Stryker staff. Maintaining GPA and enrollment standards for renewed eligibility.
