

MPV (monkeypox) vaccine clinic

Protect yourself, loved ones, and your community.

People who have been exposed to MPV, or are currently at higher risk of being exposed, can get a vaccine called Jynneos. Getting vaccinated lowers your chance of getting MPV if you may have been exposed.

When: Monday, August 29, 2022
10 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Who:

- Anyone aged 18 years and older who has had close physical contact with someone who has MPV in the last 14 days.
- Gay, bisexual, or other men who have sex with men, or transgender, non-binary, or gender-diverse people aged 18 years and older who:
 - Have had multiple sexual partners in the last 14 days, or
 - Have had sexual partners they did not previously know in the last 14 days, or
 - Have had close physical contact with other people in a venue where anonymous or group sex may occur.
- Anyone identified by public health as a known high-risk contact of someone who has MPV.
