Downtown Greeley

From downtown, you can take 8th, 9th, 10th or 11th, Avenues heading south to 16th St. At the light, turn right onto 16th Street. NCMC will be on the right. Ft. Collins/Cheyenne via I-25

Take I-25 south to the Loveland/Greeley Hwy 34 Exit. Go left at the exit, heading east. Take the lane for East 34 that says Ft. Morgan/Greeley. As you come into Greeley, you will take the 23rd Ave. exit. At the light, turn left onto 23rd. Take 23rd Ave. to 16th Street. At the light, turn right onto 16th Street.
