Summary: Implementation of new program approved in 2019

Background: The Board of Trustees approved a new Graduate Certification in Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education in 2019. This program is in the School of Teacher Education, College of Education and Behavioral Sciences. Because this is a teacher licensure credential, it required additional oversight by the Colorado Department of Education (CDE). Upon review, CDE requested a number of modifications to the proposed curriculum. These changes have since been developed and approved at the course level, so the CDE has now given us full approval to begin offering the program. We expect to enroll students as early as Fall 2022.
