2-3-304(2) Emeritus Faculty. Tenured faculty members and/or administrators in good standing who have served at the University for ten years or more and who have attained the rank of professor or associate professor will automatically be nominated, at the time of retirement or at the time of Reduction in Force due to financial or program exigency, by the President to the BOT to become emeritus faculty. University faculty members and/or administrators in good standing who have served the University for a period fewer than ten years and who hold the rank of professor, associate professor, assistant professor or instructor, regardless of how long they have served, may at the time of retirement or at the time of Reduction in Force due to financial or program exigency, also be nominated for emeritus status. Such nominations may be made by the appropriate department chair/school director, the dean, CAO, or the President. Nominations, except those originating with the CAO or President, shall be submitted to the CAO, who will forward his or her recommendations to the President. The President may make such a recommendation to the BOT. The BOT shall take final action on all nominations.

Tenured faculty members and/or administrators in good standing who have served at the University for ten years or more and who have attained the rank of professor or associate professor will automatically be nominated, at the time of retirement or at the time of Reduction in Force due to financial or program exigency, by the President to the BOT to become emeritus faculty. University faculty members and/or administrators in good standing who have served the University for a period fewer than ten years and who hold the rank of professor, associate professor, assistant professor or instructor, regardless of how long they have served, may at the time of retirement or at the time of Reduction in Force due to financial or program exigency, also be nominated for emeritus status. Such nominations may be made by the appropriate department chair/school director, the dean, CAO, or the President.

Nominations, except those originating with the CAO or President, shall be submitted to the CAO, who will forward his or her recommendations to the President. The President may make such a recommendation to the BOT. The BOT shall take final action on all nominations.
