New Business

- Commencement Speaker Selection Process/Subcommittee M. Welsh, C. Moore and B. Markowski will be on this subcommittee. We met with Anna Green (Campus Events) to review previous process and move speaker selection to October for more time to receive candidates.
- UNC Research Day Planned Changes (Crow): Change the research day; representation from many areas on the research day committee. Students hesitate to participate, some due to highly regarded research excellence awards programs. We have found that once students have participated, their energy becomes ignited surrounding doing this type of work. We have been looking at other kinds of naming done at other institutions; "showcase of artists and scholars" or "festival of artists and scholars." Rebranding and pushing promotions to dept chairs, change of framework, desire to attract any and all students to participate. Changing the perception and move research awards from showcase or festival day and so everyone presents in a more celebratory way. Comments on showcase vs. festival? Use the word students or not? Allow space for faculty to present or serve as secondary authors. UGC members expressed support for "student showcase of artists and scholars." Any feelings surrounding moving the research excellence awards programs. There is support for using the word "artist" to encourage PVA students. Support was also expressed for moving the research excellence awards day to the Fall before the National competition.
