What Is It?

- The curriculum is tailored to individual students' developmental needs (see back panel for more information).


Who Should Register For UNIV 101?


- Transfer students, Veterans and non-traditional students who need help transitioning to the challenges and expectations of the university

- Any undergraduate student interested in the topics


