Tour Size and Ratio

Groups are limited to 100 students per visit, but we recommend a group size of 60. Availability is based on campus resources. **One chaperone for every 10-15 students is required.**

Timely Arrival

Please make every effort possible to arrive early for your visit. Our tour guides are all current UNC students and may not be available beyond the scheduled time. Late arrivals will likely result in the adjustment of your schedule or elimination of scheduled activities. If you are running late, please contact the Group Visit Coordinator immediately, so we can attempt to adjust your visit schedule.

Cancellation or Schedule Change

Please notify the UNC Group Visit Coordinator of any changes to your visit including number of people attending, times of arrival or departure, or if you are cancelling *at least 48 hours in advance*.

Appropriate Dress

Please remind students that this is an **outside walking tour** and should wear appropriate footwear and outerwear.

Lunch

If you would like to take advantage of our discounted \$5 lunch option at one of our dining halls, please request lunch be added into your schedule. If lunch is included in your schedule, you will be provided \$5 lunch coupons by your tour guide. The dining halls offer a variety of food options and are buffet style. The \$5 lunch option is not available for group visits with a scheduled starting time after 11:00am due to dining hall hours of operation.

Note: Schools with 50% or more of their students on free/reduced lunch may qualify to have their meals provided by UNC. Meals are limited and will be granted on a first come first serve basis per semester. Requests must be submitted to the UNC Group Visit Coordinator in order to receive approval.

Respect

Keep in mind that as an institute of higher education, our campus and community should be treated with respect. Please remind students to be polite and considerate to their presenters and tour guides. Our tour guides reserve the right to end a tour at any point due to inappropriate behavior.

In an effort to create the best experience for all, we request that all guests turn off cell phones prior to your arrival on campus. Groups are not permitted to use any electronic devices during UNC presentations or while on tour (e.g., cell phones, iPods, etc).
